



COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

Olympic Theatre Arts (OTA) is dedicated to providing a safe environment for all our visitors, patrons, volunteers and staff.

YOU MUST HAVE VALID PROOF OF VACCINATION OR A NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST (*performed within the past 72 hours*)

THE FOLLOWING ARE ACCEPTABLE AS PROOF OF FULL VACCINATION (FOR PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF 12):

- Vaccination card (which includes name of person vaccinated, type of vaccine provided and date last dose administered).
- A photo of a vaccination card as a separate document.
- A photo of the attendee's vaccine card stored on a phone or electronic device.
- Documentation of vaccination from a healthcare provider electronic health record or state Immunization Information System record.

***Self-reported vaccination records that are not verified by a health care provider cannot be accepted.**

THE FOLLOWING ARE ACCEPTABLE AS PROOF OF A NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULT (FOR PERSONS WITHOUT A VALID PROOF OF VACCINATION):

- Printed document (from the test provider or laboratory).
- An email or text message displayed on a phone or electronic device from the test provider or laboratory. The information provided should include name of person tested, type of test performed, and date of negative test result.

***Self-reported negative test results that are not from a test provider, a laboratory, or a health care provider cannot be accepted.**
